Priority Issue	<p>Indonesia is the biggest archipelago country in the world. It gives us opportunities that we can harness, yet it gives us inevitable challenges that should be addressed carefully. One of the hardest challenges is the inequality of skills amongst young leaders in each region. Furthermore, they experience the difficulties in accessing mentorship that is suitable to their unique problems.</p> <p>On the other hand, IIFA has prominent figures and experts who are really keen to go down and “get their hands dirty”. It means they are open to share the skills and life wisdom for young leaders who are struggling to deliver impact in their neighborhood and region.</p> <p>To be added, the mentoring should be a right platform that brings IIFA altogether and to share the awareness of IATSS forum all over Indonesia. Closing of the mentoring program in which all mentees must present the assignments on what insight they have applied in the community based on the mentoring programs 4.
