





IATSSフォーラムは、毎年 ASEAN諸国から研修生を招聘し、"Thinking and Learning Together (共に考え、共に学ぶ)"をモットーにプログラムを実施し、これまでに約950名を超える修了生を輩出してこられました。研修を終え帰国されたみなさまは、各国の産業界、政界、教育機関を始め、幅広い分野においてご活躍されており、今後は、IATSSフォーラムのプログラムを通して相互理解を深めた各国の仲間との繋がりをさらに強め、ASEANの、そして世界のリーダーへと成長していかれることと期待しております。

現在、本県には、約4万2千人の外国人住民がいらっしゃいます。そのうち約1/4の方々は、IATSSフォーラム研修生のみなさまと同じ ASEAN諸国ご出身であり、ASEAN諸国の方々は身近な存在となっています。

また、本県では、近年、海外からの観光客誘致をはじめ、本県企業の海外展開の促進、県産品の海外への販路拡大など、経済分野にも力を入れているところです。2014 (平成26) 年も、タイ、マレーシアを訪問し、IATSSフォーラム設立に深く関わられたマレーシアのマハティール元首相と会談を行うなど、ASEAN諸国との様々な交流を深めてきたところです。その結果、2015年3月にはマハティール元首相にご来県いただき、30周年を迎えるこの年にIATSSフォーラムにもご訪問いただけたことは、非常に感慨深いものがあります。

2016年5月26日、27日には、志摩市を会場に「伊勢志摩サミット」が開催されることになり、本県の素晴らしい自然や産業を世界のより多くのみなさまに知っていただく千載一遇のチャンスととらえ、世界とのつながりを一過性に終わらせることなく、世界に開かれた三重をめざしていきたいと考えています。

IATSSフォーラムのシンボルマークは、三重の県木である神宮スギと、三重の「三」を表していると伺っております。世界のリーダーが集い、 国際社会の諸課題を話し合う三重の地で、これまでの30年にわたる経験と実績を活かし、三重とASEAN諸国との「架け橋」となってくだ さる世界に羽ばたく若きリーダーを、さらに多く育成していかれることを大いに期待しております。

最後になりましたが、IATSSフォーラムのますますのご発展と、関係者および研修生のみなさまのより一層のご活躍とご健勝を祈念いたしまして、設立30周年のお祝いの言葉とさせていただきます。

IATSS Forum Introduction

Purpose

The IATSS Forum is an international training institute established in 1985 that aims to bring out the best qualities in individuals who may one day become future leaders in the ASEAN region.

Inviting young and outstanding individuals from respective ASEAN countries, the IATSS Forum provides an invaluable experience for young professionals to meet. The Forum provides opportunities for participants to understand each other's' countries through well planned seminars, field studies, group study, and cultural exchanges, as well as collaborative efforts to discuss and solve current issues in the ASEAN region and Japan, under the IATSS Forum motto of "Thinking and Learning Together."

The Forum Program is designed by the IATSS Forum Program Committee, which comprised of intellectuals from various academic communities. The issues are revised regularly taking into consideration current international development. Top-class lecturers from academic and business circles are invited to share their experiences with the participants, with the aim for them to understand various diverse issues in Japan and ASEAN.

History

The IATSS Forum was established with private funds from Soichiro Honda, founder of Honda Motor Co., Ltd and his business partner, Takeo Fujisawa. The inaugural IATSS Forum program begun with participants from Malaysia in September 1985.

The initial program was originally held with participants from one country at a time for the first few years after its establishment. However, from 1991, this program was revised to become the ASEAN Forum, with several ASEAN countries participating together at the same time. During the 30 years since its inauguration (as of November 2015), the IATSS Forum has been held 54 times, having produced approximately 950 alumni members.

Today, IATSS Forum is a 55-day program, inviting 18 participants each time, twice a year, from the ASEAN countries to Suzuka City, Mie Prefecture, Japan, where the Forum is held.

Principles

Leadership Training

The IATSS Forum is not a program intended for merely learning new knowledge or experiences in Japan. Instead, the core principle of the Forum is to "develop Asia's next-generation leaders" through collective thinking and sharing among the participants in achieving their leadership development goals. By the end of their stay in Japan, the Forum aims to develop leaders who will be able to continue to care, lead and inspire their local communities upon return to their countries.

How the IATSS Forum Defines "Leader"

A Person who is able to maximum the potentials of each team member in creating a high performance team in achieving goals together.

Ideal Teammates for Improving Leadership Skills

Participants in this Forum, who come from different social, cultural backgrounds and nationalities, are Asia's future potential leaders who will play an active role in various fields such as governmental institutions, research institutions, and enterprises. Forming a group with participants from different backgrounds, they are able to tap on the wealth of knowledges and experiences from each other's expertise in various fields in collaboration team work.

This is the underlying principle in which the program of this Forum is based. Our primary objective is for each participant to improve his or her potentials as a leader, as well as the ability to lead high performing teams.

Program to Support Participants

To that end, the program of this Forum is based on the participants' independent attitude. It is a challenge by choice for participants to set their own standard of achievement, discover their strengths and work on their weaknesses in becoming stronger leaders. IATSS Forum support the participants' efforts and facilitate their learning and team effort under our motto of "Thinking and Learning Together".

Mindset the Forum Requires

- It is the collective responsibility of the participants to attain their level of learning in the program.
- Each participant shall take responsibility for their team's activities.
- Participants shall not only accumulate knowledge but also use their own knowledge and experiences in order to solve issues.

IATSSフォーラムは、ASEANのヤング・プロフェッショナルが集う場です。ASEAN各国から若く優秀な人材を日本に招請し、 "Thinking and Learning Together (共に考え、共に学ぶ)"をモットーに、セミナー、フィールドスタディ、グループ研究、文化交流などを通じて、参加研修生が互いの国について理解し、ASEANと日本の現在の課題に取り組む場です。

↑ 経緯

IATSS フォーラムは、本田技研工業株式会社の創業者である本田宗一郎と藤沢武夫の両氏の個人基金により設立されました。

1985年9月に第1回IATSSフォーラムのプログラムがマレーシアから研修生を招請し開講されました。設立当時は各国単位での開催でしたが、1991年からはASEANフォーラムとして、各国単位から複数国参加のIATSSフォーラムに変容しています。発足以来30年間(2015年11月)で、54回のIATSSフォーラムが開講され、約950名の同窓生を輩出しました。

今日では、ASEANから毎回18名の研修生を三重県鈴鹿市に招請し、55日間のプログラムを実施しています。

● 理念

IATSSフォーラムは、単に新しい知識を学び、日本という異文化を体験してもらうためのプログラムではありません。当フォーラムの狙いは、あくまでも「次世代のアジアのリーダーを育てる」ことにあり、そのために必要となるリーダーシップとは、「目標の達成に向けて、グループが持つ力を最大限に発揮させることのできる能力」であると、私たちは定義しています。

About the IATSS Forum Program

The IATSS Forum Program is mainly classified into three categories: the general seminar area, the theme study area, and the general areas of study. The training programs feature academic, practical, and well-balanced programs, which are not specialized in any specific fields. Although the IATSS Forum is advertised as "leadership training," it does not directly deal with content for learning leadership skills and expertise. Through the comprehensive 55-day program, the Forum is intended for participants to learn the skills, ideas, and mindsets required to become young leaders

The IATSS Forum Program's is organized and reviewed by the IATSS Forum Program Committee in order to provide training contents that match current international and regional situations.

© Group Study Energizes the Forum ~The Torch has been Passed~

In its beginning years, IATSS Forum individual participants prepared and presented their reports based on their respective country research activities during their stay in Japan. As a result, the Forum was not able to achieve its objective of providing opportunities for participants to practice its motto, "Thinking and Learning Together."

In the 10th Forum (1988), when Singapore first joined the IATSS Forum membership, group study was introduced in the program. This revision enabled participants from different countries to work on a single theme and share their ideas and values with each other. However, though the participants were from the ASEAN community, cultures and customs still differ. Due to the differences among participants in the interpretation of the theme and common awareness of the issues, they argued on different wavelengths and failed to connect well with each other.

To rectify this new challenge, team-building training was introduced in the from the 31st Forum program in 2002. The aim was to provide a better understanding and team collaboration effort among the

participants. This resulted in a better Forum program where there were collegiality between participants and a sense of unity that grew for every batch of participants ever since.

In 2003, Myanmar became the ninth member country. In the 38th Forum (2005), another revision saw a stronger emphasis placed on project proposal-type group research/study. In addition, during study tours in Tokyo, the Forum program included regular courtesy visits to the participants' country embassies that allowed the ambassadors and participants to interact, and strengthen the relationship with IATSS Forum. Furthermore, embassy representatives who attended the participants' group study presentation session praised them for their dedication and high levels of awareness, and acknowledged the value of the IATSS Forum.


On the occasion of the 20th Anniversary of the IATSS Forum in 2005, we introduced the concept of "mobility," which had been widely used in the transport sector. At that time, the IATSS parent organization suggested that transportation-related issues to be among the topics for group study. However, this proposal was rejected out of concern that the number of applicants might decrease by limiting participants to those only in the transport sector. It would also digress from the original intention of the Mahathir-Honda Meeting. As a result, the decision was then, for the main theme of group study to be chosen instead, from among the United Nations Millennium Development Goals (UNMDGs), which were more familiar to participants from the ASEAN region.

With the fresh revision in the recent IATSS Forum program, the participants were expected to study the synergy effects of "mobility," a keyword for society with traffic safety, and "sustainability," a buzzword in global society, in the process of community development design for their respective countries. The programs were designed to encourage participants to seek ways to realize a "Society with High Mobility" under the UNMDGs. Around that time, the Japanese government amended corporation laws as part of administrative reforms (2009-2013), Under the renewed law, the IATSS was authorized as a public interest incorporated foundation in April 2011,

At the 10th IATSS Forum International Advisory Committee Meeting held in November 2012, members further discussed a major shift in the basic policy of IATSS Forum activities. The results of the meeting were compiled into a document called the "Suzuka Declaration 2012." At the 7th IATSS Forum International Alumni Meeting held in Hanoi, Vietnam in June 2013, approximately 120 alumni members discussed how they could contribute to society by drawing on the knowledge and skills they acquired in the Forum training. The results were summarized into the "Hanoi Declaration." Through both of these international meetings, the IATSS Forum has evolved into what it is today. In accordance with the IATSS Forum founding motto, and with a sense of gratitude to HONDA for its assistance, we now operate business activities for community purposes as a new public interest incorporated foundation.







On the coming occasion of the 30th anniversary of the IATSS Forum in November 2015, I would like to voice my opinion that the "approach to mobility," is an expression used by Japanese people, and could be replaced by a more appropriate English word, "mobilization". Following "sustainability," the concept of "human security" should also be introduced in future group research/study as a key perspective in creating an ideal future society. I have submitted this idea to the IATSS Forum Steering Committee (See figure above).

My proposal is grounded on the following reasons. Based on 16 years of my experiences in the United Nations development operations and public-private international cooperation. I can say that "mobility" has more of a dynamic nuance of advancement and development for quality improvement at the proper speed, whereas "sustainability" carries a very static nuance of the status of continued security, safety and stability that requires certain quantity of social infrastructure.

To achieve a balance between these two vectors that differ subtly, the human security perspective is necessary. Like the term "sustainability," which has been globally used in many disciplines and fields since the 1980s, "human security" has been popular since the mid-1990s. The United Nations and other institutions have provided the definitions of the concept and the debate over the definition is still continuing. The Government of Japan is among the most active advocates of human security. With contribution of US\$10 billion from the Japanese government, the Trust Fund for Human Security was established in the United Nations. Japan's foreign policy was revised for the first time in 60 years by including "human security" as the fourth pillar of its basic foreign policy. Against this background, the Japanese Foreign Minister's Commendations were awarded to the IATSS Forum, an institution that has reached a 30-year milestone.

The Forum's achievements are far beyond what can be produced by an ordinary CSR initiative. With the IATSS Forum, Honda Motor Co. Ltd was a trail blazer in the establishment of the forum, Mr Honda has greatly contributed to global society in his time. In this way, the torch has been passed.

● グループ学習・研究でフォーラムが活性化 ~松明は引き継がれた~


今日では、グループ研究・学習がIATSSフォーラムの主軸となっているが、第1回の開講当初から取り入れられていたわけではない。当初は個人の研究テーマに対するレポート作成とその報告が主な取組みだったため、フォーラムの基本理念である「共に考え、共に学ぶ」が実践されていなかった。そこで、シンガポールが加わった第10回(1988年)に初めてグループ研究が導入され、研修生たちは1つのテーマについてお互いの考えや価値観を共有しあえるようになった。しかし、ASEANと一言で言っても国によって文化や習慣が違うため、テーマの捕らえ方や問題意識に差があり、議論が噛み合わず研修生同士の一体化が進まないという事態が発生した。そこで第31回(2002年)からチームビルディング合宿を導入し、研修生の緊張をほぐすと共にお互いのパーソナリティやバックグランドを理解することで相手の意見を聞くという姿勢が身につけられるようになった。その結果、グループ内で孤立したり、反発する研修生の姿は見られなくなり、研修生に体感が生まれるようになった。更に、2003年にミャンマーが加わり9ヶ国参加となった。第38回(2005年)からプロジェクト提案型のグループ研究・学習に重点が置かれるようになった。現在では東京視察時の各国大使訪問が定着化し、各国大使館員がグループ研究発表会に臨席の際には、研修生の取組み姿勢や意識の高さを称揚下さると共にIATSSフォーラムの価値も認めていただいている。

IATSSフォーラム創設 20周年の境として、交通関係者の間では極く当り前と言われる "モビリティ"概念の導入が図られた。それに伴い IATSS本部からの提案で "交通関連"がグループ研究のテーマの1つとして推進されたこともある。ところが最初のマハティール・本田対話の趣旨からして対象者を交通関係者に限定してしまうと応募者が減少するのではないかと懸念された。こうした事情を鑑み、グループ研究・学習の総合テーマを国連のミレニアム開発目標(MDGs)から順次取り上げ参加者に身近なものとした。各国の「地域開発」をデザインする過程で交通安全社会のキャッチコピーたるモビリティと国際社会で広く馴染みあるサステナビリティの相乗効果を狙いつつ、リーダーシップ研修を通じて "Society with High Mobility"の実現を目指すという経過を辿っている。時を同じくして 2009 ~ 2013年の日本政府の行政改革に伴う法人法の改正があった。

2012年11月に開催した第10回国際諮問委員会にてIATSSフォーラムの活動方針にギアチェンジが図られ、その結果を『鈴鹿宣言』にまとめた。更に第7回国際同窓会では、約120名の同窓生がフォーラムで培った知識とスキルを活用しどの様に社会に貢献していくのかを「ハノイ宣言」にまとめた。こうしてIATSSフォーラムは創設以来のモットーとHONDAからの支援に感謝し、且つ新公益財団としての事業評価にふさわしいIATSSフォーラム実現への歩みを続けて今日に至っている。

30周年を機に、日本語で用いられる"モビリティ"への接近は、英語用法のmobilizationの方が原意に適っていると筆者は考える。それ故、サステナビリティと繋ぎ、"人間の安全保障"(Human Security)の概念を将来への中核軸としてグループ研究・学習に導入することをIATSSフォーラム実行委員会に提示している。(右図参照)





理由は、筆者が16年に亘る国連の開発業務や官民による国際協力の実態を踏まえると "モビリティ"が程よいスピード感を持った質の向上を目指す進歩発展の動的ニュアンスが先行するのに対して、"サステナビリティ"には安心・安全・安定が持続する事、またそのために或る程度の量的な社会インフラ充足を要する静的ニュアンスが豊かに存すると考えられる点にある。

この微妙に異なる2つのベクトルを調和、発展させるのが人間の安全保障であると考えられる。後者が1980年代から世界的に汎用されて来た如く、ヒューマンセキュリティは90年代半ばから今日に至るまで国連中心に概念の定義が図られている。他ならぬ日本政府も100億ドルを国連に施しヒューマンセキュリティ基金を創設して、外交方針を60年振りに変更し、ヒューマンセキュリティを4番目の軸に据えた。この度30周年を迎えたIATSSフォーラムに対し外務大臣表彰の次第となった証左は此処にもある。

HONDAの単なる社会貢献を百倍にも優る実績は、IATSSフォーラムを通じ文字通りグローバルな参与の好例となっていると言える。こうして松明は引き継がれた。

The Last Decade of the IATSS Forum (2006–2015) ~Going beyond Maturation~

The ten-year span between the 20th and 30th IATSS Forum gatherings was, in many ways, a period of maturation that brought us to an important juncture. As we forge ahead, we now need to formulate a vision that stretches even further beyond that maturation process. In this essay, I will explore some of the changes that the Forum has experienced over the course of its history, its achievements in the last decades, and outline issues for the future.

Since 2003, 9 of the 10 ASEAN countries—Brunei being the only exception—have taken part in the IATSS Forum. The program started as a single country participation per year which eventually expanded to include all the five original members of ASEAN community in an effort to promote mutual exchange and learning. As more nations joined ASEAN in the 1990s, the IATSS Forum welcomed the new members into the fold and eventually arrived at the current number of 18 participants per program.



Over the years, the qualifications and credentials of Forum participants have shown remarkable improvements. Despite substantial economic disparity among the participating ASEAN countries, there are hardly any gaps in ability and knowledge separating individuals capable enough to make it through the rigorous screening process to participate in the Forum. As the ongoing surge of globalization continues to produce stronger levels of information literacy and positive changes in the English-learning environment, our future leader participants are demonstrating an increasingly level of impressive set of skills.

At the same time, it is worth noting that these highly capable participants consistently give the Forum programs high marks, praise the balance of seminars, group-study projects, field observation, and other activities. In addition, the participants are able to understand the spirit of the Forum in not only sharing wide-ranging knowledge and issues between ASEAN countries and Japan and but also in opportunities to connect with local volunteers through cultural exchange events. Over the past years, many participants have been showing a stronger interest in finding more opportunities to meet and interact with the Youth of Japan.

The Forum, which originally aimed to provide a platform for learning Japanese modernization in the spirit of the "Look East" policy, gradually moved away from using the Japanese experience as a model after the "Bubble Economy" burst and her economy sunk into a prolonged slump. The new focus shifted to leadership development training. The Forum Program Committee then worked to replace the curriculum of Western individualistic, performance-driven leadership concepts with something more optimal for the Asian community—that is, the understanding of a co-creative, group-focus leader with the ability to forge consensus in solving issues.

In terms of leadership development approaches, the Forum Program focus on team building workshops to cultivate teamwork-oriented environments, incorporate facilitation skills, and made group study a core activity under the Forum's motto of "Thinking and Learning Together". In addition, the IATSS Forum Program Committee has also transformed the seminars from adhering to the traditional one-sided, "show-and-tell" lecture style, to a more inclusive seminar couple with country-by-country presentations and lectures, and field studies. Moving forward, Program Facilitators will need to continue to maximize on participants' interactions to forge deeper connections with the histories, economies, societies, and cultures of the ASEAN community and make their lectures even more relevant and meaningful for their participants.

At the IATSS Forum alumni level, through the efforts of the biannual International Alumni Meetings, a network of social contribution at the ASEAN-wide level is already starting to form through project proposals that aim to benefit communities. At the same time, these project proposals help to continue to strengthen and energize alumni activities in the ASEAN region.

The final point I would like to address is where the IATSS Forum should go from here, During the preparation for the 20th Forum in 2005. we discussed the idea of creating a transportation-focused "Mobility Forum" to reflect our connection with IATSS—our parent-research organization that specializes in transportation. We ended up shelving the idea, but reached an agreement to include profiles of IATSS research activities in Forum programs to coincide with the organization's transition into a public-interest corporation at the 2012 International Advisory Meeting. On the table for discussion now is the idea of strengthen the curriculum for group studies—the Forum's core initiative—around the idea of "Mobilization for Sustainability & Human Security". This would help expand the concept of the Mobility Forum from a narrow focus on "transportation" into the realm of the "mobilization" of resources for healthy national development.

「IATSSフォーラムの10年(2006~2015) ~成熟を超えて~

IATSSフォーラム実行委員 足立 文彦

IATSSフォーラムの20周年から30周年にかけての10年間は、いろいろな意味でフォーラムが成熟を迎えた時期で、今、それを超えるヴィ ジョンが求められるに至ったと言える。ここでは必要に応じてフォーラム創設以来の推移にも言及する形で、この10年間の成果と課題を明 らかにする。

フォーラム参加国について、2003年以来ASEAN10マイナス・ブルネイの9カ国として、ほぼすべての国がそろった。当初、ASEAN 創設5カ国の国別プログラムとして出発したフォーラムは、その後、ASEAN諸国相互の交流と学びを重視する意味で、5カ国すべてが参 加する合同プログラムへと発展し、1990年代に新たにASEANに加盟した国々を追加して今日に至っている。

フォーラム参加者については、近年の資質の向上が顕著である。国レベルの経済格差は大きいが、慎重な審査を経てフォーラムに参加す るほどのエリートの能力の格差は極めて小さい。近年のグローバル化に伴う情報リタラシイの普及と英語学習環境の好転が、将来のリーダー となるべき人材の能力向上をもたらしている。その意味で、優秀な参加者が、プログラム全体について高い満足度を示し、セミナー・グルー プスタディ・フィールド視察などのプログラムのバランスを高く評価し、ASEAN諸国と日本の幅広い知識や課題の共有、文化交流会などを 通じてのボランティアとの交流などに、フォーラムの理想を実感していることは特筆に値する。加えて近年では、日本の青年との交流機会全 般の増加を望む研修生も多い。

フォーラムの目的について、当初は "Look East" の精神に即した日本の近代化の経験を学ぶ場として位置付けられたが、バブル経済の 崩壊と日本経済の低迷を背景に、モデルとしての日本の経験の意味が薄れた。その結果、フォーラムをリーダーシップ研修の場と位置づけ、 アジアに求められるリーダー像を模索し、個人主義的・業績主義的な欧米型リーダー像に代えて、グループ中心的で合意形成を重視する共 創型リーダー像を打ち出した。

リーダーの育成手法として、チーム・ビルディングを重視し、研修の導入部にチーム・ワーク養成のための合宿とファシリテーション・ス キルを組み入れるとともに、Thinking and Learning Togetherのコア活動としてグループ・スタディを位置付け、それを補完するセミナー を編成した。したがって、セミナーそのものも、かつての一方的な日本紹介型の講義形式を廃し、国別プレゼンと講義が一対になるように工 夫され、セミナーとリンクしたフィールド・スタディが用意された。今後、講師陣自体がフォーラムでの対話に刺激されて、ASEANの歴史・経済・ 社会・文化等に関心を持ち、講義内容が、研修生にとって一層意味のあるものとなるように努力することが求められる。

草の根型の社会貢献を模索するグループ・スタディの成果をプロジェクト提案に結び付けたことによって、同窓会活動の活性化が見られる ようになり、国際同窓会などを通じて、ASEANレベルの社会貢献のネットワーク化が近い将来に実現しそうである。

最後に、フォーラムの方向付けについては、研究調査を目的とするIATSS本体との関係で、20周年の際に、交通安全を主眼とする Mobility Forum導入が検討されたが棚上げされた。この点については、一方で、公益法人化と2012年の国際諮問委員会を契機に、フォー ラムのプログラム中にIATSS本体の研究活動の紹介を組み入れることが合意された。他方、Mobility Forumの在り方については、交通 安全という狭義のイメージにとらわれず、国づくりに必要なリソースの動員・活用(Mobilization)という視点から、Mobilization for Sustainability & Human Securityをフォーラムのコア活動であるグループ・スタディのガイドラインとすることが検討の俎上にある。

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IATSS Forum Program Development: Features and Prospects

Member of the IATSS Forum Steering Committee Associate Prof. Nagahiro Yoshida

1. The history of the principles and basic policies behind the IATSS Forum

The IATSS Forum is a professional leadership training program started by Mr. Soichiro Honda, after a dialogue with the former Malaysian Prime Minister Tun Dr. Mahathir bin Mohamad.

When the Forum programs first begun, the participants were given not only opportunities to experience Japanese culture and society, but also to understand Japan's rapid economy development and its good practices in the 1980s-90s. As Southeast Asia countries started to improve their economies, the Forum continued to revise the program regularly to align to its core principles and international development. At the November 2012 International Advisory Meeting, the respective ASEAN and Japan Chairpersons declared a new medium- to long-term basic framework, naming it the "Society with High Mobility." They also endorsed the Suzuka Declaration to hold fast to the principles of the IATSS Forum Leadership Training as to further strengthen the training objectives of seminars, field studies, and group study on the theme of society with high mobility.



In order to realize the Suzuka Declaration into actual action plans, the IATSS Forum Steering Committee and Program Committee held extensive discussions on the framework not simply within the confines of "transportation" but rather in terms of "mobilizing all types of resources." These plans thus form the foundation for the IATSS Forum's framework from henceforth.

2. Features of the IATSS Forum training programs

The IATSS Forum training program's strengths lies in its cultural exchange programs linking Japan and the ASEAN communities, its well-thought through choices of general seminars, and its emphasis on core thematic study.

Forum participants not only learned about Japan's economic development issues, her responses to challenges and effort to improve, but also new insights and divergent perspectives from their fellow participants' social contexts. The Forum programs provide participants with leadership opportunities to engage in constructive discussions on different opinions and viewpoints through team-building activities, facilitation workshops, and conflict-management training. By delving deep into important themes and respecting each other's' perspectives, the programs enable participants to put the Forum motto—"Thinking and Learning Together"—into practice.

The basic program format generally follows four steps:

Step 1: Developing team-building, conflict-management, and facilitation skills

Step 2: Learning and discussing the seminars' key points

Step 3: Observing and holding workshops on important domestic field trips

Step 4: Engaging in group discussions after the seminars

In the case of Step 3, the Program Committee carefully planned and selected suitable domestic field trips so that they would have the most impactful learning for the participants in understanding Japan's context, The field trips include different organizations such as private companies, NGOs, government agencies across multiple time frames—the past, present, and future—and the divergent perspectives of residents, corporations, and government. Organizations that hosted participants also benefitted from the different perspectives and ideas the participants brought to the table, bringing IATSS Forum "Thinking and Learning Together" motto to a whole new level. Instead of previous merely presenting case studies, host organizations now started to share their challenges with participants such that more possible solutions could be generated together for these issues.



3. Current program topics and future possibilities

The two current main topics for the Forum now are "sustainable development" and the "sustainable community design", both of which have been gaining higher international attention since the late 1980s.

Although the effort to design "sustainable communities" is aligned with the Forum's focus of "mobilizing all types of resources," different issues require different solutions and processes. In short, there can never be a simple generic answer to all the issues. Nevertheless, with the highly motivated and talented Forum participants, they are able to make the best use of the limited time they have together to deliver as a team, remarkable outcomes through deep, critical thinking and active discussions.

As program designers, not only do we want the participants to experience leadership development through collaboration and team work, we also want them to take strong initiatives in coming up with actionable plans that can help to solve communities' issues.

At IATSS Forum, we are committed to review our programs regularly, taking into consideration the dynamic changes in our complex world. We are constantly tailoring our programs to whatever conditions that come along and helping to develop our Leaders of Tomorrow.

♠ IATSSフォーラムプログラム開発の特徴と今後への期待

IATSSフォーラム実行委員(プログラム編纂統括) 吉田 長裕

1. IATSSフォーラムの理念、基本方針の経緯

IATSSフォーラムは、マレーシアのマハティール首相と本田宗一郎氏によって開設された人材育成研修である。当初のプログラムはいわゆる文化交流的な側面に加え、日本の近代化のプロセスや課題等を講義形式で短期的に受講できるプログラムとして出発した。その後、東南アジアを取り巻く情勢の変化に伴い、フォーラムの理念、基本方針も、時代に即した改善が求められるようになった。近年のプログラムは、2012年11月に開催された国際諮問委員会において、「Society with High Mobility」という中長期的なフォーラムの基本方針が提唱され、「IATSSフォーラムの理念(人材育成)を堅持しつつ、モビリティ社会を題材としたセミナー・現地視察・グループスタディに一貫性をもたせた戦略的な研修体系に進化させるため、さらにプログラムの検討を進める」という鈴鹿宣言を受けたものである。実行委員会やプログラム委員会ではこの鈴鹿宣言をいかに実現していくかについて検討を重ねてきた。とくに、"Society with High Mobility"をただ単なる交通という狭義の意味で捉えるのではなく、「あらゆる資源を適材適所に活用 (mobilize) する」という広義の解釈が加えられ、具体的なリーダーシップ要件の一つに位置づけられるようになった。

2. 研修プログラムの特徴

本フォーラムの特徴は、日本、ASEAN相互の文化交流プログラムや一般セミナーに加え、テーマスタディに最も力を入れているところである。様々な経験や知識を持った研修生たちは、日本の経済発展の過程でどのような課題に直面し、どう対応してきたかや日本の最先端の取り組み事例について学ぶことで、研修生個人や社会属性による視点の違いに必ず直面することになる。こういった異なる意見や視点に基づいて議論を建設的に進めることができるように、プログラムでは、チームビルディング、ファシリテーションスキル、コンフリクトマネジメント等を修得する機会が提供されている。研修生の視点の違いを尊重しながら議論を深く掘り下げることで、フォーラムのモットーである「Thinking and Learning Together」が実践できるようになっている。

プログラムは以下4つのステップを基本スタイルとして実施している。

ステップ①: チームビルディング、コンフリクトマネジメント、ファシリテーションスキルの修得

ステップ②: テーマに関わる基礎知識に関する講義および討議

ステップ③: 国内における特徴的な事例を対象とした視察・ワークショップ

ステップ④: テーマに関して学んだことについての徹底したグループ討議

特にステップ③において、日本において彼らに示すべき事例にふさわしいものは何か、また日本或いは日本人の特徴として伝えるべきことは何かという点については、プログラム委員会で多くの議論を重ね、該当する候補事例を選定してきた。また、事例の構成においては、民間企業、NGO、政府機関等の異なる組織の取り組みを網羅的に取り入れ、過去、現在、将来といった時間軸や住民や企業、行政といった異なる視点軸を組み合わせることで、事例を多角的に俯瞰できるように配慮している。特に近年では、研修受け入れ先も研修生の視点やアイデアに期待しており、単に事例紹介だけで終わるのではなく、受け入れ先が現在抱えている問題を研修生と共有しワークショップなどで一緒に解決策を考える事例もあり、「Thinking and Learning Together」の進化もみられる。



3. 現在のプログラムテーマと今後の展開

現在は、1980年代後半以降世界規模で取り組まれている「持続可能な開発」「持続可能な地域・社会づくり」をテーマとして取り上げている。「持続可能な社会」の実現には、「あらゆる資源を適材適所に活用(mobilize)する」というフォーラムの基本方針に沿うものであるが、扱う問題によって解決策やそのプロセスも異なるため、決まった答えが必ずしも用意されているわけではない。それでも、優秀な研修生達はこれらの問題に立ち向かい、限られた時間の中でグループダイナミクスをうまく活用し、深い考察と熱心な討議に基づいたすばらしい研修成果を挙げている。

我々プログラム提供側が研修生に期待しているのは、こういった経験により、困難な状況を打開するための様々なアイデアの引き出し 方やチームとして力を発揮することの重要性であり、研修生自身やその周辺にある様々な課題に立ち向かう勇気と行動力をもってもらうこと である。今後も、ASEANを取り巻く情勢は目まぐるしく変化することが予想されているが、こういった変化に即したプログラムを提供してい けるようプログラム内容を常に見直し、引き続き、優秀なリーダーが羽ばたいていけるようにしたい。

Commemorating the 30th anniversary of establishing IATSS Forum, we invited Tun Dr. Mahathir bin Mohamad , (4th Prime Minister of Malaysia), Mr Yasuhei Oguchi (Former President of IATSS, Japan), and Dato' Zuraidah Atan , (Chairperson of the IATSS Forum Malaysian Committee and alumnus of the IATSS Forum, Malaysia) for a special interview.

Tun Dr. Mahathir advocated the idea that "the source of future development of the ASEAN region lies in human resources development," which inspired the establishment of the Forum in 1985.

It is Important to Enhance the Qualities of Individuals

Prof. Mizota

The IATSS Forum was established in 1985 by Mr. Soichiro Honda, the founder of Honda Motor Co., Ltd., as a training institute for developing young leaders who will shape the future of Southeast Asia. This year marks its 30th anniversary. Mr. Honda founded the Forum which originated from a discussion with Tun Dr. Mahathir.

At the start of the Forum Program, we received valuable suggestions and ideas from Professor Ungku Aziz, a Royal Professor of the University of Malaya. Since its inauguration, the Forum has invited to Japan approximately 950 young people from nine ASEAN countries, including 172 from Malaysia, producing outstanding future leaders who had made vital contributions to the development of their home countries. What do you think about the social significance and impact of



Tun Dr. Mahathir

In a developed country, people cannot fully depend on the government to do everything for them. The role of the private sector is significant. When developing people, imparting concrete knowledge alone is not enough. It is also important to enhance the qualities of the individual. When we speak of the qualities of the individual, our concern is not only whether the person is intelligent, well-educated and knowledgeable, but rather how that person can contribute to society.

Even if you possess excellent knowledge, if you are unable to use it properly, then it is not good for society. Therefore, we need to be in an environment where people who have acquired correct knowledge can use it properly, and to that end, training is essential

I consider that success—whether at the individual or national level—largely depends on values. If the values rooted in a country's culture are nurtured in people's minds in the "right" way, then the people of that country will succeed. No matter how much knowledge one has accumulated, no one can succeed unless they have the right values. Only by fostering the right values, it is then possible to develop individuals who will lead well in the future. If a person has the right values, they can play a role of building society with a positive attitude.

I think IATSS has played a wonderful role in fostering young people over the past 30 years.

Prof. Mizota

You mean that it's important to enhance the qualities of individuals.

Since the launch of the IATSS Forum in 1985, many promising young professionals have been invited to Suzuka to attend the program. Mr. Soichiro Honda said that his encounter with Tun Dr. Mahathir in Malaysia was the catalyst that started the Forum.

Tun Dr. Mahathir

I am very pleased that Mr. Soichiro Honda took my words so seriously and that the IATSS Forum has continued its activities for as many as 30 years.

The Forum has invited young people from ASEAN countries to Japan to allow them to interact with Japanese people and learn about each other's cultures and differences. I believe that these experiences will cultivate a spirit of tolerance and broad-mindedness in both the people of Japan and ASEAN.

As society progresses, advances in science and technology alone tend to attract much attention. More often than not, such advances occur frequently without a right driver. However, scientific and technological advances alone are not sufficient to achieve the goal of a better future. The qualities of people must be improved along with scientific and technological advances. I think the program of the IATSS Forum has contributed greatly to society from the perspective of human resources development. Since we are living in a global village now, and if there is good understanding between each of us, then all of society can benefit from that,

溝田委員

IATSSフォーラムは、1985年に、東南アジアの将来を担う若手人材の育成機関として、本田技研工業株式会社の創業者本田宗一郎氏によって設立され、本年、30周年を迎えます。

これはマハティール閣下のお考えを本田氏が具現化したもので、立ち上げの際にはマラヤ大学のウンク・アジズ氏に、多大のご示唆を頂きました。これまでマレーシアからは172名、ASEAN9カ国から約950名の若者を招聘し、各国の国づくりに貢献できる優秀な人材を輩出してきたと自負しております。

こうした民間レベルの活動が世の中に与える社会的な意義について、どのようにお考えですか。

マハティール閣下

先進国において、すべてを政府に頼るわけにはいきません。民間の役割は大変大きいのです。人を育てる上で、具体的な知識を与えるだけでなく、やはり人材の資質を高めることが重要になります。人材の質というのは、知的で高い教育を受け、知識があるというだけではなく、その人がいかに社会に貢献できるかという点が重要です。

せっかく得た知識を上手く活用できなければ、社会にとってよく ありません。ですから、正しい知識を得た人たちが正しくそれを 使う事ができる環境が必要になり、そのためにはトレーニングが必 要です。

成功というのは個人レベル、国レベルに限らず、価値観によるものが大きいと考えています。それぞれの文化に根差した価値観、それが正しい力タチで醸成されていれば、その国民は成功していくのです。どれだけ知識が蓄えられたとしても、そこが出来ない限り成功は難しいでしょう。ですから、将来を担うリーダーを育成するには正しい価値観が確立していなくてはならないのです。そうすれば前向きな姿勢で彼らが社会を構築していく役割を担うことができるのです。

IATSSフォーラムは過去30年においてそういった仕組み作り、 人づくりをしており、素晴らしい役割を果たしていると思います。

President Oguchi has continued to observe many alumni members over the past 30 years. How do you feel seeing participants grow through the program and playing active roles after returning home?

President Oguchi

Participants from the ASEAN region all have sound ideas and are very sincere. They also have a great attitude in the way they approach things. We have accepted many participants from diverse backgrounds. Every one of them had grown and matured significantly by the end of the training program

I've also had many opportunities to meet and interact with alumni members. I've witnessed many Forum alumni playing active roles as leaders in various fields in their respective countries. It's really amazing, and I am always moved and feel very proud.

Prof. Mizota

Dato' Zuraidah, you serve as the chairperson of IATSS Forum Malaysian Committee and are also an alumnus of the IATSS Forum. What impact has the IATSS Forum had on ASEAN countries and on your life?

Dato' Zuraidah

Yes, I participated in the IATSS Forum in 1993. I thought and learned together with other participants from the ASEAN region and learned a lot about Japan during the program period of 2 to 3 months.

I learned how to use the knowledge I had acquired, and the importance of understanding the language and culture from the aspects of politics, economics and law. We, the participants from the ASEAN region, returned home, after having learned many things through case studies on challenges in Japan. After returning to our home countries, we were able to move forward based on what we had learned and acquired from the Forum. I once served as president of the Alumni Association and am currently serving as the chairperson of the Malaysian Committee. I feel very honored about that.

A strong alumni network has been built in each country, and ${\bf I}$ think the IATSS Forum's alumni network will continue to grow stronger.

Tun Dr. Mahathir, in "Vision 2020" that you promoted, you stressed the importance of not only economic growth, but also social and cultural development, Please tell us more about this.

Tun Dr. Mahathir

There are developed countries and developing countries in the world, and there are distinct gaps between them. Many developing countries set their goals on catching up with developed countries, but I feel that too much emphasis is placed on economic development.

I think that there should be a different definition of "developed country" than the traditional definition that emphasizes economic development. Of course, it is important to be affluent, but this alone doesn't mean that the country is developed. Even if a country is recognized as developed, the country may not be so affluent in real terms. Some countries are classified as developed only because of their advanced science & technology and social structures.

In Vision 2020, Malaysia set the goal of becoming a fully developed nation by 2020. Malaysia aims to become a developed nation with its own characteristics, not just copying what other developed countries are doing. I believe that a being a developed nation is not just about achieving a high gross domestic product (GDP). It also means having well-organized educational systems, strong industrial production capability, and research institutes with strong research & development and technological innovation capability. In my opinion, a developed nation is a country that is advanced not only economically, but also in all other aspects including social contribution. We are aiming to become a developed nation with our own characteristics and values.

We set out Vision 2020 to define what a developed nation is like. In those early days, we needed to shape what we wanted to be as a developed nation.

ズライダー氏

そうですね、私は1993年にIATSSフォーラムに参加させて頂きました。ASEANからの研修生たちと共に考え共に学び、プログラム期間中の2~3ヶ月間で日本について多くのことを学びました。

吸収した知識をどのように使い、学ぶのか、また政治、経済、 法律などの側面から、言語、文化を理解していくことの大切さを 学びました。我々 ASEAN からの参加者は、日本の成功体験、 失敗体験の両方から、日本をお手本にしていろいろなものを持ち 帰ったわけです。私たちが母国に帰った時に、その経験をもとに 前進することができたのです。同窓生の代表として同窓会会長を 務めたこともありますし、現在ではマレーシア委員会の委員長も 務めさせていただいており、とても喜ばしく思っております。

IATSSフォーラムは各国でも同窓会組織として非常に強い繋がりができあがっておりますし、今後ますます強くなっていくと考えています。

港田委員

マハティール閣下が推進されたビジョン2020の中で、経済的な側面だけではなく、社会的そして文化的な観点の重要性に触れられていますが、その点についてお聞かせください。

マハティール閣下

世界には先進国、まだまだ開発途上の国があり、この国々の間にはギャップがあります。もちろん、開発途上国の目標としては先進国に追いつくことが重要視されがちですが、経済発展というところに重点が置かれすぎていると思います。

しかし私は、先進国の定義とは、経済発展重視のものとは違ったものであるべきではないかと思います。もちろん豊かになるということは重要ですけれども、必ずしもそれによって先進国というふうに見なされるわけではありません。また、先進国と見なされていても、実質はそこまで豊かではないかもしれないし、科学や、社会構造のみが進んでいるということで先進国と考えられている国もあります。

マレーシアはビジョン 2020 の中で、2020 年までに先進国になるというビジョンを掲げていますが、他の先進国の真似をするのではなく、私たち自身の特性を持つ先進国になるということを目指しています。例えばGDPだけではなく、教育面でも整備され、工業生産の能力を持ち、研究機関が能力を発揮する。経済だけの問題ではなく、社会への貢献という意味でも、あらゆる面で進んでいる国、それが先進国なのです。ですから我々が目指しているのは、私たち自身の特性、価値観を持った、先進国になるということなのです。

先進国とはいかなるものなのかという定義としてビジョン 2020 年を打ち出しましたが、当時、私たちは先進国としてどうなりたい のかを形づくる必要がありました。



The Key Word is Global Culture

Prof. Mizota

You led Malaysia as its prime minister for over 20 years. What sort of beliefs did you have then?

Tun Dr. Mahathir

To become a leader, you need to understand what needs are present in society and meet them. I always kept thinking about what people and society demanded.

Of course, the needs of people and society are constantly changing, so one must be sensitive to those changes. For example, when society is poor, it is a privilege to receive an education, so people feel grateful if they are provided with education. However, when society becomes rich, education becomes the right of all children. When society arrives at this point, such things as justice, fair systems and transparency are demanded. Leaders should always pay attention to those changes.

Prof. Mizota

I would like to ask you about leadership. Young leaders from the ASEAN region come to Japan and play active roles. What kind of leadership do you think is required of ASEAN and Japanese youths to become good leaders?

President Oquchi

First of all, it is important to think about others.

To be more specific, the hardware and software have already been developed. I think what will become important in the future is "mindware." Tun Dr. Mahathir also talked about "mindware" today. I think that to become a good leader, it is most fundamental to acquire "mindware".

Prof. Mizota

This is the last question for today. On the occasion of the IATSS Forum reaching the 30th year milestone, could you give some message for the program, looking to the next 30 years?

Tun Dr. Mahathir

I think that the IATSS Forum should continue its activities long into the future.

Both participants from ASEAN countries and Japanese people can learn a lot from each other. The significance lies in the fact that such an exchange has been occurring in Japan and it should become better.

There is a prevailing notion that what is occurring in the West is right. But we need to change that notion itself. Instead of leaning to one side—be it the East or the West, or the North or the South, we should regard the entire world as a global culture. We should not accept something as right simply because it is from the West. We also should not only repeat the past. For example, the power of Western countries is on the wane, and power is shifting to the East. Eastern countries can benefit from cultures of other countries, by looking at the whole world, not just the East or Asia. We must look at the whole world and consider what is best.

President Oguchi

"Global Culture!" That's an important keyword, isn't it?

Prof. Mizota

So, the keyword for the future is global culture.

The IATSS Forum will continue to provide a place of learning. Thank you very much for taking precious time out of your busy schedule for us today.

溝田委員

リーダーとして20年以上に渡りマレーシアの首相を務めていらっしゃいましたけれども、どの様な信念をお持ちだったのでしょうか。

マハティール閣下

リーダーになるにはまず、社会にどの様なニーズがあるかを理解し、それを提供していく必要があります。私は、国民や社会が求めていることを常に考え続けてきました。

もちろんニーズは刻々と変わっていきますので、その変化も捉えなくてはいけません。例えば、貧しい時代に教育を受けることは特権ですので、教育が与えられれば感謝されますね。しかし社会が豊かになってくると、教育を受けるというのは当然の権利になってくる。そうなると次に求められるものは、正義、正当なシステム、そして透明性といったものになります。ですからリーダーは常にその変化に注意を傾けなければならないのです。

溝田委員

リーダーシップについてに伺いたいと思います。ASEANの若手リーダーの方々は、日本に来て、非常に活発に活動されておりますが、ASEANそして日本の若者に対して、良いリーダーになるために、どういったリーダーシップが求められていると思われますか。

小口会長

まず一つは、相手のことを考えるということが大事です。

もう少し具体的に言いますと、ハードウェア、ソフトウエアというのは既に発展してきましたが、それに次いでこれから大事なのは、マインドウェアだと思っているんです。今日は閣下からもマインドウェアの話がございました。そういうものをキチッと身につけていく、それがリーダーシップの一番基本ではないかというふうに思っております。

溝田委員

最後の質問になりますけれども、IATSSのプログラムに対して、 30年経った今、今後の30年を見据えて、何かメッセージをいた だくことはできますでしょうか。

マハティール閣下

もちろん今後も継続していくべきです。

ASEANの国々から招聘した参加者の方々にとって、そして日本の方々にとって、お互いに学ぶものがあると思います。こういった交流が日本で起こっているということが重要なんです。

例えば、今の傾向として西洋で起こっていることが正しいものだという考えがありますが、その考え方自体を変える必要があります。世界の文化として、東洋や西洋、北や南に偏るのではなくて、世界全体をグローバル・カルチャーと捉えるべきです。西洋のものだから正しいと鵜呑みにしてはいけないし、過去の繰り返しではいけません。例えば、西洋諸国の力は衰えつつあり、その力は東に流れてきています。一方で東洋は、この東洋・アジアだけを考えるのではなく、世界全体を考えることで他の国々の文化からもいろいろと恩恵を受けることができます。世界全体に目を向けて、何がベストなのかということを考えていかなくてはいけません。




For the Next Decade: Beyond Maturity

Chairperson of the IATSS Forum Steering Committee Prof. Kenji Doi

Reaching a 30 year milestone, the IATSS Forum has entered its maturity stage. While its achievements have been highly recognized in Japan and abroad, the Forum needs to continue to forge ahead in making timely changes to achieve further development. The IATSS Forum Vision 2015 sets out what we should firmly maintain and what we should change for the next decade after reaching our maturity

The collective efforts of many people who have been involved in IATSS Forum activities produced the following results that have international and social value:

- 1) Developing young leaders who can contribute to nation-building in their respective fields and countries in the ASEAN region.
- 2) Creating a strong human network among Japan and ASEAN countries.



These achievements were affirmed when the IATSS Forum received the Japanese Foreign Minister's Commendations in August 2015.

Vision 2015, from henceforth, must focus on creating new values, while firmly maintaining the above achievements. Then, what should be the new values? To identify that, we need to review the concept of "Ideal Mobile Society," which was adopted as a principal goal in the purpose of the foundation of IATSS, by re-examining the key word of the concept--"mobile".

The term "mobile," or "mobility," which has been widely used in various fields, has both positive and negative connotations. Flows of human, goods, money and information are indispensable to modern society. However, demand for a mobility level that is too high has often brought about negative impacts on society, causing safety and environmental problems and fragmenting communities. For this reason, cynics say that the improvement of mobility itself cannot be the end for society, but merely the means. The "ideal mobile society" can be defined as a sustainable society in which mobility does not have negative impact that threatens human survival.

Moving ahead, IATSS Forum adopted the theme of "Mobilizing Resources for Sustainability and Human Security" to help realize an ideal mobile society. In line with this theme, we can then mobilize the resources needed for building resilient and sustainable societies and communities in the ASEAN region, where the countries are expected to achieve further economic development. As a concept succeeding "Society with High Mobility," which was declared at the 2012 International Advisory Committee Meeting, this basic theme sets out future directions for the creation of more international and social values.

30周年の節目を迎え成熟期に至ったIATSSフォーラムは、その功績が内外から高く評価されるとともに、さらなる飛躍に向けた変化が求 められています。成熟を超えた次の10年に、何を堅持し、何を変えるべきか、それを示すものがIATSS Forum Vision 2015です。 これまでフォーラム活動を支えた多くの方々のご努力の積み重ねにより、IATSSフォーラムは以下のような国際的社会的価値を生み出し てきました。

- 1) アセアン各国各界のリーダーとして国づくりに貢献する人材の育成
- 2) 日本とアセアンとの懸け橋となる堅固な人的ネットワークの構築
- 3)「共に考え、共に学ぶ」異文化間の真の相互理解や協働の実践モデルの構築
- こうした価値が評価され、IATSSフォーラムは本年8月に外務大臣表彰を賜るに至りました。

Vision 2015は、これらの取り組みを堅持しつつ新たな価値を加えるものでなければなりませんが、その価値とはいかなるものでしょうか。 これをIATSSの理念に刻まれた「理想的な交通社会」(Ideal Mobile Society)の核心にあるMobileという言葉に立ち返り、再整理する

既に多様な分野で用いられている Mobile あるいは Mobility という言葉は、元来、正負両方向の含意を持ちます。人、モノ、カネ、情報 の流れは社会の維持に欠かせない血流ですが、高すぎるモビリティへの欲求はしばしば安全問題、環境問題やコミュニティの崩壊など社会 への負の影響をもたらしてきました。それゆえ、Mobilityの向上自体は社会の目的とはなりえず、単なる手段に過ぎないと揶揄されます。人 の生存を脅かす負の影響を伴わない持続可能な社会の姿がIdeal Mobile Society でしょう。その実現に資するIATSS フォーラムの行動方 針を、われわれは「Mobilizing Resources for Sustainability and Human Security」と表現します。すなわち、一層の経済発展が 期待されるASEAN各国における、しなやかで持続可能な国・地域づくりに必要なリソースの動員・活用(mobilize)です。この方針は、 2012年の国際委員長会議で提唱された基本方針「Society with High Mobility」に続く、さらなる国際的かつ社会的な価値創造の方向 性を示すものです。
