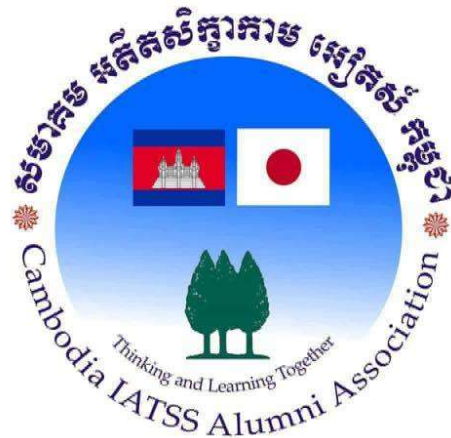

Objective / Purpose of the Project	<p>1. Environment for energy saving workshop</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To raise the awareness of the impact of excessive use of electricity on rising global temperature. - The amount of energy needed to operate the different household electrical appliances. - To encourage individuals to adopt positive habits so as to reduce electricity consumption. These habits may include but not limited to the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Switch off electrical appliances or unplug from the socket when not in use. - Use natural lighting during the day. - Use energy efficient electrical appliances such as energy saving light bulbs instead of incandescent light bulbs. - If air conditioner unit is required, maintain the temperature at no lower than 25 degrees Celsius. <p>2. Leadership for Teachers</p> <p>To develop the leadership skill to Teachers who will be then develop the young generation to pursue their dream of study.</p>

	<p>3. Charity Event</p> <p>To contribute to the school library the reading books and study materials for less fortunate children in the rural who have limited educational resources. We have also the chef team from Academy of Culinary Art Cambodia (ACAC) who prepared their own made donut and breads for the students.</p> <p>4. Mangrove Plantation</p> <p>To plant the mangrove, which are the formations that shelter coastal areas as habitat for wildlife as the protection tool against wave in Trapeaing Sangke Community, in which people are relying their lives on fishing and the community development.</p>

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5. Project Background

Cooling Cambodia Project has been created in order to response to the Global Climate Change by tackling extensive waste of energy, which contributes to the causes of Climate Change. This initiative was the result of group discussion of 48th batch. CIAA's alumni joining the batch namely Ms. Theary Tith (Jamie) and Ms Sotheany Lay (Theany), have brought back the concept, adapt and apply accordingly. The project has been so far successfully reached its sixth phase, being implemented in different locations and schools in order to maximize the impact throughout Cambodia's society across cities and provinces.

Project Cooling Cambodia is organized by Cambodia IATSS Alumni Association (CIAA) and associated with International Association of Traffic and Safety Sciences (IATSS) Forum – Japan. Project Cooling Cambodia is initiated to educate the young generation how important their daily activities impact the global environment. Specifically, the project brings the awareness of electricity consumption in urban households and its implications. The project's objectives aims at raising awareness of the impact of excessive use of electricity on raising global temperature and to encourage individuals to adopt positive habits so as to reduce electricity consumption and to combat the climate change as a global concern of environmental issues. The project target is the students from grade 6 or 7, with aged between 11 -12 years old in both state school and private school. Moreover, Cooling Cambodia has been upgraded to the program which consist of the workshop session on energy saving, clean environment, charity and knowledge sharing session.

We have provided some useful tactics to those young children to play very importance role to contribute the knowledge to enable them to change their mind-set for their positive behaviors toward environment.

6. Project Preparation

The project has been prepared a year earlier and has been discussed in CIAA's annual meeting in early 2018. The project has been set out as per schedule to be conducted in August 2018. However, due to the raining season and the road condition was not good, we have move the schedule to end of September 2018.

We have planned for the venue in Kampot Province as this is one of the potential province in tourism, investment, social economical development, where medium level family are living in the city and the poor are living in the outskirts.

Of course, some roles have been backed up by other team members, when some could not make it.

We have also firstly come up with the numbers of participants we have expected, so that we could arrange the transportation and the accommodation.

The project has been made available through the strong support from IATSS Forum and our members, CIAA. However, to have the bigger impact from the project, we extend the participation from the volunteers and call for the support from sponsors. We have formed up the sponsorship package: Gold and Silver sponsor, in which we invite their representatives to participate in the event.

7. Activities of the project

The project has combined 4 key activities including the hand on experience on energy saving, develop the teacher on the leadership, motivate students to study hard, share them the hand made donuts and mangrove plantation.

a. Workshop

We have conducted one workshop on Love the Earth, Save Energy in the whole morning at Sovannaphumi School, the private educational institution, in which the students 'living status is in middle class and in which their family are using electrical equipment's and high consumption in electricity. The team has great, warm welcome from the school branch manager and the nice greeting from the students. The team has got off the bus with a full handy of materials, equipment's, and refreshment for students. The team was so excited with the readiness of the students as they were going to perform a role in a short education scene and the presentation related to energy

saving. The workshop agenda has been well managed by our both cheerful MC: Vanna and Theany and been actively participated by the students as well as the handfull help and facilitation of, CIAA's member, sponsors, and volunteers. Please find the program agenda in the appendix. In the afternoon session, we have trained the teacher on Leadership to enhance their leading capacity to train the students to become great leaders like them.

b. Leadership Seminar To Teacher

Mr. Sy Vanna, CIAA's Vice President has shared his knowledge and experiences to develop the Teacher to another level to enable them to lead the classroom and students more effectively. The teachers are also expected to develop students to become the great leaders like them.

c. Charity

Although the students living in the city are fortunate to study in private school, there are some kids who, are less fortunate with limited study materials and basic need. Seeing this issue, the team has arranged reading books, study materials sponsored to Raksmeay Sangkros School's library so that the teachers have the teaching resources for the students besides the classroom study. Moreover, the team has delivered the school pack, food and blankets for the less fortunate students.

d. Team building with mangrove plantation

Every CIAA's members have their own business, jobs and roles. Gathering the team would take some times and all could not show up. This was great opportunity that CIAA's members, sponsors, IATSS Forum delegates, and volunteers. While at the same time, supporting to the mangrove plantation community in Trapaing Sangke, which is the shelters for the wildlife.

11. Project Result

170 students and teachers have participated in the program, of which 50 secondary school students has joint the environmental seminar in Sovannphumi School, in Kampot Province and another 100 primary school students in Raksmeay Sangkros Primary school, in Kampot Province. We have 25 volunteers & sponsors who have made the program succeed.

12. Financial Report

We have worked out the project with the budget allocated from IATSS Forum, CIAA's members and sponsors, as found in the appendix as Financial Report.

13. Conclusion

It was not a year or two that CIAA has brought back the Project Cooling Cambodia. It is not a big program which would have targeted so many people, but we believe small things worth sharing. This program has been conducted for the 8 times, with the satisfactory results. From the start of the program, we have made an impact to 1040 beneficiaries including students and teachers with the help and supports from 141 volunteer's participation.
