This expertise would help the local community to establish the waste management and link the coffee plantation into eco-tourism.</p> <p>- Ngoepi is an organization that have been experienced in Indonesia coffee industry. This expertise would help the local community to gain the knowledge on coffee business in Indonesia.</p> <p>Sebumi and Ngoepi are currently in partnership to initiate a social movement called 'Rebuild Rinjani' – a post disaster project after 7 richter scale earthquake in Lombok, Indonesia.</p>

<b>Theme</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Sustainable community design through strengthening economic pillar</li> <li>- Educating community and local coffee farmers about coffee business and how to make it sustainable</li> </ul>
<b>Priority Issue</b>	<p>Senaru Village is located at the foot of Mt. Rinjani, a famous hiking mountain in Indonesia.</p> <p>However, major earthquakes in August of 2018 have not only caused serious damages to human lives, properties, infrastructure, and society but also affected the resilience of the local inhabitants whose livelihood rely mainly on providing porter services for tourists to Mt. Rinjani, which has been closed since the earthquake.</p> <p>Based on the project team's knowledge and practical experience gained from the IATSS Forum, building a sustainable community for Senaru Village is essential to ensure sustainable income as well as the capability to deal with future disasters.</p> <p>To address this issue, the project team proposed the following solutions: First and foremost, it is necessary to support local people to build and develop a value-added product based on available resources in order to find alternative and stable sources of income – which is producing coffee and embed it to the eco-tourism in Senaru Village.</p>
<b>Goal</b>	Leveraging the knowledge about coffee business as the alternative source of income for the local community
<b>Objective(s)</b>	Community knows how to manage the coffee business and establish the strategy to make it sustainable.
<b>Location</b>	Senaru Village, Lombok
<b>Activities</b>	Workshop and role play
