Title	Relief Operations Project
Beneficiaries	Selected Communities of Isabela, Cagayan, Bicol, and Rizal – Philippines
Duration	One-day activity in each of the 4 identified municipality/barangay (November 2020)
Budget	USD2,000
Theme	Emergency Assistance to the Victims of Floods Through Relief Operations
Priority Issue	Geographically, the Philippines is vulnerable to natural disasters such as typhoons and flashfloods. On 13 November 2020, typhoon ‘Ulysses’ brought heavy rains and widespread flooding over the country in almost all parts of Metro Manila, Central and Southern Luzon, some parts of Visayas and Mindanao, and specifically in the Northern part (Isabela and Cagayan). Families have lost almost all their personal belongings and properties. Initial assessment shows that immediate needs for these people now include safe drinking water, temporary shelter, food aid, hygiene kits, and medicines.
Goal	Given the situation in the affected communities, the goal of this project is to provide immediate basic needs to the vulnerable groups such as children, women, elderly, disabled and indigenous minorities. Priority will be given to less fortunate people heavily affected by the flood.
Objective(s)	To assist the victims of floods with integrated relief operations

1. Kasiglahan Village, Montalban, Rizal	- Food Aide - Drinking Water - Hygiene/First Aid Kits	USD 650	For relief operations	The area is classified as urban poor community, a relocation site for displaced informal settler families all over Metro Manila since 2014.
2. Cabagan, Tumauni, Isabela		USD 450		Located near Cagayan River; mostly poor farm labourers; Badly affected by the flood.
3. Barangay Linao, Tuguegarao City		USD 450		Located near Cagayan River; Badly affected by the flood.
4. Oas, Albay, Bicol		USD 450		Badly affected by the flood and lahar flow
